Research Program Update

Over the winter, our team focused on:

- Sorting and analyzing marine debris data from 2024
- Mapping redfish and Calanus copepod (zooplankton) distribution and abundance
- Reviewing audio recordings from passive acoustic devices to detect whales and other marine mammals
- Watching and analyzing over 17 hours of ROV footage from Bonne Bay and St. Paul's Inlet
- Planning research activities for the 2025 summer field season
